ONGOING OR REPEAT LARGE PROJECTS

McGill Bird Observatory	Support funding for bird banding station activities
Tadoussac Bird Observatory	Support funding for bird banding station activities
Rimouski Bird Observatory	Support for banding operations
Corridor Appalachien	Multiple research projects focused on monitoring specific species in the Appalachians
Développement ornithologique Argenteuil	Several projects, such as monitoring of Chimney Swifts, Tree Swallows

INDIVIDUAL OR SPECIFIC PROJECTS

Union Québécoise de réhabilitation des oiseaux de proie (UQROP)	Funding towards a project to develop exhibits for a new discovery centre
Birds Canada	Contributed towards cost of participant materials for the Marsh Monitoring Program
Snow Bunting Banding	Support for local volunteers collecting data for submission to the Canadian Snow Bunting Network
Eastern Bluebird Nest Box Network	Funded several expansions of a network of boxes in the St-Lazare area, which has grown to over 300 boxes installed and maintained
Morgan Arboretum	Educational project to set up an observation window allowing visitors up-close view of birds without disturbing their feeding, including making the conservation centre windows birdsafe.
Kahnawà:ke Environment Protection Office	Project to create field guides in English and Kanien'kéha (Mohawk) and to install Eastern Bluebird nest boxes on the territory
CEGEP Vanier	Funding for expenses related to MOTUS project at their field station
University student research grants	Annually, provide funding to multiple Master's and PhD students' research work directly related to bird conservation
Elementary school nature projects	Grants to several boards and individual schools not only in the Greater Montreal Area but in the Gaspé, south-western and south-central Quebec, which support projects that include setting up feeders and studying birds, taking students on field trips, buying binoculars for shared use by students, engaging speakers, with the aim of fostering an appreciation for birds, conservation and nature in general
